Getting started with OverDrive app

Step 1: Install the OverDrive app from your device's app store or from app.overdrive.com.

Step 2: If prompted, sign into the OverDrive app.

- Tap on Sign Up button
- Tap on "Sign up using library card."
- Enter "Barrington Public Library" into search box. Tap on library's name.
- Enter library card number and PIN.

Step 3: Find and save eZone in the OverDrive app. (This may not be necessary.)

Step 4: Open eZone, sign in, and borrow a title.

- Tap on "Add a title" to find eZone titles.
- Sign into eZone with library card number and PIN.

Step 5: Borrowed titles will appear on your Loans page on eZone. From here, you can:

- Add titles to your bookshelf in the OverDrive app
- Read, watch, or listen to titles right in your browser (without adding them to the app)
- Send Kindle books to your Kindle device or Kindle reading app



Download the OverDrive or Libby app from your device's app store to your media device. Read or listen on-the-go!

Getting started with Libby app

Step 1: Install the Libby app from your device's app store.

Step 2: If prompted, sign into the Libby app.

- Select "I'll search for a library."
- Enter "Barrington Public Library" and select "Ocean State Libraries eZone."
- Add your library card and PIN. This will automatically sign you into eZone.

Step 3: Libby defaults to Library (bottom of app), which is eZone.

- Find titles to borrow on this side. From here, you can add titles to your shelf.

Step 4: Select Shelf to view what titles you have borrowed, and to adjust settings.

- Read, watch, or listen to titles right in your browser (without adding them to the app).
Send Kindle books to your Kindle device or Kindle reading app.

Getting started with Kindle

This is for Kindle e-readers only. Kindle Fire devices can follow "Getting Started with OverDrive app."

Step 1: Use a computer, tablet, or smartphone to open eZone (via website, or OverDrive or Libby app).

Step 2: On eZone website, use the search filters to find and borrow an eBook that's available in Kindle format.

Step 3: From your Loans page, select the Kindle Book format for your borrowed eBook. You'll be taken to Amazon's website to complete your checkout.

Step 4: On Amazon's website, follow the on-screen prompts to "Get library book" and wirelessly deliver it to your Kindle e-reader. You'll need to sign into (or create) an Amazon account to complete this process.

Note: Kindle e-readers require a Wi-Fi connection to download library Kindle books from Amazon. If you don't have a Wi-Fi connection, you will need to transfer the Kindle book to your Kindle e-reader via USB.

OverDrive Read

What is OverDrive Read?

Browser-based ebook reader that works on computers, tablets, and mobile devices with compatible web browsers.

How do I start using OverDrive Read?

Once you borrow an ebook from eZone, click/tap the **Read now** button on your Loans page to begin reading it immediately using OverDrive Read.

What are some of its features?

OverDrive Read has many of the same features as popular reading apps, including the ability to add bookmarks, search for terms, add notes and highlights, look up words, and change the font.

Can I use OverDrive Read without an internet connection?

Yes! On most devices, select **Offline Access** from the OverDrive Read menu, then the cloud icon to cache (download) an ebook so you can read it offline. Make sure to also bookmark the ebook in your browser or save the ebook's URL so you can get back to it in your browser once you're offline.

OverDrive Listen

What is OverDrive Listen?

Streaming audiobook player that works on computers, tablets, and mobile devices with compatible web browsers. Borrow audiobooks and listen to them right in your browser with a single click—no software or downloads required.

How do I start using OverDrive Listen?

Once you borrow an audiobook from eZone, click/tap on the Listen now button on your **Loans** page to begin listening to it immediately using OverDrive Listen.

What are some of its features?

With OverDrive Listen, you can change your playback speed, add bookmarks, and make notes and highlights in borrowed audiobooks.

Can I use OverDrive Listen without an internet connection?

No. OverDrive Listen is a streaming audiobook player, so you'll need an active internet connection to use it. If you'd like to listen to an audiobook without an internet connection, download it to the OverDrive or Libby app. Since OverDrive Listen uses a lot of data, a Wi-Fi connection is recommended when streaming on a mobile device to avoid data overages.
