Interlibrary (ILL) Loan Policy

The Barrington Public Library is a member of the Ocean State Libraries Consortium (OSL), which means a library card issued from any OSL library will allow a library user to borrow materials from any OSL member library, free of charge.

Rhode Island library users are also able to borrow materials from non-OSL Rhode Island libraries and out of state libraries, using the Interlibrary Loan (ILL) service. The ILL is governed by the Library of Rhode Island (LORI) standards.

A user may request materials through ILL at the Barrington Public Library location by contacting a reference staff member. There is no guarantee that the materials requested will be available from another institution. There is no charge for placing an ILL request, but if we are able to obtain the requested title, the library user is required to pay \$2.00 shipping fee and is responsible for normal fines and fees for overdue or lost materials.
